December Mission Partner - Hurricanes 2024 Relief Efforts

Hurricane Helene landed in Florida on September 26 as a category-four storm. It brought a devastating 20-foot storm surge and 140 mph winds. After landfall in Florida's Big Bend region, the storm proceeded northeast into Georgia, western South Carolina, western North Carolina, and eastern Tennessee as a category one storm. Over 230 people have been confirmed dead.

On October 9th, 2024, **Hurricane Milton** landed on Florida's west coast, less than two weeks after Hurricane Helene devastated the region.

As we continue to pray for and support those who have experienced unimaginable loss this past week, **we invite you** to support the UCC's recovery efforts.




In MHUCC's recent member survey, members suggested having more opportunities to get together around the table.
